

ESSENTIAL TOOLS INSTALLATION GUIDE

Congratulations on the receipt of the 2013 Mitsubushi Essential Tool Cabinet Organization System.

This system allows for the existing Stanley Vidmar Cabinet to be utilized as your Mitsubishi Essential Tool Cabinet. Please follow the directions below for proper installation of the tool ID labels, partitions, dividers, and tools. Place Essential Tools Master Index in drawer #1 for future reference.

DIRECTIONS: Drawers 1-7

REMOVAL

- 1. Remove all existing tools from drawer 1 to drawer 7 in your current cabinet system.
- 2. Utilize the existing divider and partitions. Additional dividers are supplied to complete this upgrade.
- 3. Remove all existing faceplates.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Starting with Drawer #1, relocate any required **partitions** indicated by the **shaded vertical lines** on the drawer diagrams listed in this guide using the provided **Divider Measurement Gauge**. Please store any remaining partitions for future use.
- 2. Install the **dividers** indicated by the **shaded horizontal lines** on the drawer diagrams listed in this guide using the provided **Divider Measurement Gauge**. Please store any remaining dividers for future use.
- 3. Open the Drawer #1 ID Label envelope.
- 4. Apply each Tool ID Label on the face of the divider **BEHIND** THE TOOL STORAGE LOCATION. Labels for tools in back location to be applied to the inside back wall of the drawer.
 - a. Each Tool ID Label lists the tool location on the bottom left corner of the label.
 - b. Tool locations are **alpha-numeric**. The Alpha character indicates the column. The numeric positions begin at the **front** of the drawer.
- 5. Install the current required tools into their appropriate drawer locations.
- 6. Install the new drawer face plate supplied in this kit.

Repeat steps 1 thru 6 for each additional drawer until complete.
